Minutes of the meeting of JULY 16, 2020 of the Historic District Commission

A meeting of the Bridgewater Historic District Commission was held on JULY 16, 2020 at 7:30pm via ZOOM.

A quorum was present and due notice had been posted.

Call to Order: The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:35 pm.

Members present were Chairman Bill Smith, Judith Gabriel, James Kirkcaldy, Marie Benoit and Nick Palmieri.

Brian Neely, from the Architectural firm of Gale Associates,
Carlton Hunt and Gina Guasconi.

First item on the agenda is the application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for Central Square Congregational Church dated June 25, 2020 for restoration of the entire envelope of the Central Square Congregational Church,
Located at 71 Central Square Bridgewater, MA.

After hearing tentative plans regarding necessary restoration and the expected timeline of funding for their project, a motion to
"TABLE THIS APPLICATION PENDING 1. BUDGET INFORMATION AND 2. MORE SPECIFIC WORK TO BE COMPLETED"
was made (NP) and seconded (JG) and approved unanimously.

Making note that this must be reconsidered within 3 months from this date.

Under old business discussions regarding notices to Building Inspector regarding violations in the Historic District,
the planned restoration of the Memorial Building and Bridgewater Improvement Association's plan for memorial benches.
