

REGULAR MEETING**BRIDGEWATER PLANNING BOARD****NOVEMBER 18, 2020**

The regular meeting of the Bridgewater Planning Board convened virtually via zoom at 6:30 pm.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mr. Driscoll, Mr. Ajemian, Ms. Guarino, and Mr. Geller

Town staff participating were Mr. Romulus, Assistant Town Planner, and Leslie Dorr, Office Administrator

Mr. Driscoll read from prepared text on Governor Bakers order of 3/12/2020 and how the meeting will be conducted and how to be able to speak at the meeting. He advised the audience that this meeting is being recorded and will be posted within 48 hours on the Town of Bridgewater website or social web page.

66-88 BROAD STREET SPECIAL PERMIT/SITE PLAN PUBLIC HEARING CONTINUATION

The public hearing re-convened at 6:37pm.

The Board received a request for continuation to December 16, 2020 from SEA, Larry Silva, on behalf of the applicant.

Mr. Geller advised the members that there is a very good chance that he will be unable to attend that meeting due to work obligations. Since a super majority is required for a special permit, the members felt it best to further continue this hearing to January 6th. This will give the applicant more time to get additional information to the Board and for review of those documents.

Mr. Driscoll questioned if this would affect the time for action on this project? Mr. Romulus said n; the State of Emergency has stayed those deadlines and once it is started again, they have added 45 days to the requirement.

On a motion by Mr. Ajemian, seconded by Ms. Guarino, it was unanimously voted by roll call vote, to continue the hearing to January 6, 2021 at 6:30 pm.
