A. Call to Order at 2:00 pm

B. Minutes

1) January 10, 2023 Meeting Minutes

Shirley Krasinsky motioned to approve the January 10, 2023 Meeting Minutes with an amendment regarding the discussion of the Town Planner's recommendation which was duly seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.

C. New Business

1) Trees near CVS

Bill Maltby spoke on the trees near CVS and the declining conditions due to over-trimming. His concern is that they are unhealthy and should be removed due to their condition. Raymond Ajemian will speak with CVS to see if replacement trees can be procured.

Shirley Krasinsky motioned to have Raymond Ajemian reach out to CVS to procure replacement trees, two in total, which was duly seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.

2) National Grid Recommendation for Arborist

Paul DeCosta shared his recent discussion with the National Grid representative and the trimming of town trees.

3) Discussion: Original Tree Committee Proposal

Raymond Ajemian will be making a formal request to the town boards and committees to inquire about their power regarding trees. Nicole Holmes will work on requirements for arbor day and becoming a tree city.

2) Bucket Truck Inquiry
