B. Minutes

a) August 8th, 2023

C. Old Business

a) Recommended Trees

The planning board has received the recommended trees list and will utilize the list moving forward.

b) Tree City

Nicole discussed the next steps in the application for Bridgewater to become a Tree City. The Town Manager will need to sign off on the application before submission.
