Conservation Commission – Old Business

Notice of Intent – 785 Elm Street – SE116-1397

Ms. Marilyn MacDonald, Vice-Chair, opened the continued hearing.

Rebecca Baptista, Sr. Civil Engineer, Silva Engineering, Associates, Inc., explained the changes and updates made regarding the stormwater management and drainage system in detail, as noted on the revised engineered plans submitted to the office. The Commission discussed the changes.

Mr. Joseph O'Leary, Copart Senior Director of Equipment, Safety and Environmental Compliance made a presentation to the Commission regarding site operations and the maintenance, as well as the Copart Company as a whole. Mr. O'Leary provided the Commission with a copy of the site operation and maintenance manual for review, and discussed it in detail.

The Commission expressed their concern regarding potential site contamination.

Mr. Robert Mello asked Mr. O'Leary to walk him through the company's daily protocol for running the business and obtaining the vehicles, bringing them onsite, and storing the vehicles.

Mr. Azu Etoniru, Conservation Agent, noted that Copart will need a permit for site development through the Planning Board process, and that he will review the technical aspects of the proposed stormwater management and drainage system as revised.

The Commission requested that the site be staked out edge of the basin, and the edge of the parking area, closest to the buffer. Silva Engineering will advise the office with the stake out is complete.

Mr. Robert Mello, Member, motioned to continue the hearing to April 27, 2017. Mr. Matthew Stoddard, Member, seconded the motion. VOTE: All in favor, none opposed.

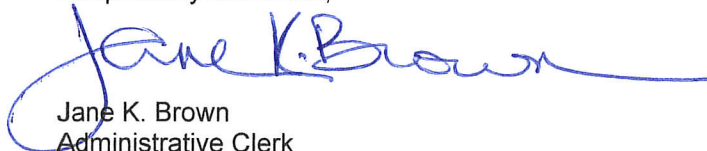
Conservation Commission Business
